

Security: Lobby Doors

On a few occasions, recently, the residential lobby doors (accessed with the building security key issued to owners) have been unlocked and left that way, presumably in order to facilitate convenient access by the guests of a certain unit. This practice is in contravention of our security standards, and disrespects the security expectations of owners and tenants.

While it can be appropriate to temporarily unlock both access doors when moving in/out large objects, under such circumstances the doors should always be monitored when open and subsequently be fully secured in a locked position.

Should you, as an owner or tenant, find the doors in an unlocked position at any time, without monitoring in place, you are encouraged to secure and lock the doors into proper position.
